
Ladybug Match 1-5

Ladybug Match 1-5

Set Up:

- Photocopy 1 page of ladybugs and 2 pages of leaves.
- Cut out and attach the ladybugs to small pebbles (usually available from the gardening department).
- Cut out leaf sheet and glue on to a backing sheet then laminate.
- Glue spinner to a backing sheet, cut out and laminate. You will need a pencil and paper clip for the spinner.

How to Play:

For 2 players.

Player 1 spins the spinner and places the correct number of ladybugs on to the matching leaf.

Player 2 spins and does the same.

Play continues with players having alternating spins.

If a player spins and they have already used that number they lose a turn.

The player who places all their ladybugs to the matching leaves is the winner.

Ladybug Match 1-5

Set Up:

- Photocopy 1 page of ladybugs and 2 pages of leaves.
 - Cut out and attach the ladybugs to mini pegs or buy pegs that already have lady bugs on them
- (I purchased mine from my local \$2 shop).
- Cut out leaf sheet and glue on to a backing sheet. Cut out each leaf individually then laminate.
- Glue spinner to a backing sheet, cut out and laminate. You will need a pencil and paper clip for the spinner.

How to Play:

For 2 players.


Player 1 spins the spinner and pegs the correct number of ladybugs on to the matching leaf.

Player 2 spins and does the same.


Play continues with players having alternating spins.
